## Cayman Islands Companies (Amendment) Law 2011

In line with its tradition of progressiveness and adaptation in offshore financial legislation the Cayman Islands is making amendments to its Companies Law. The changes follow public consultation and a period of government / private sector cooperation (including a committee on which Appleby was represented which made recommendations to government). A similar process is being undertaken in connection with the Exempted Limited Partnerships Law which will lead to changes to that law in the near term which will be the subject of a separate note.
